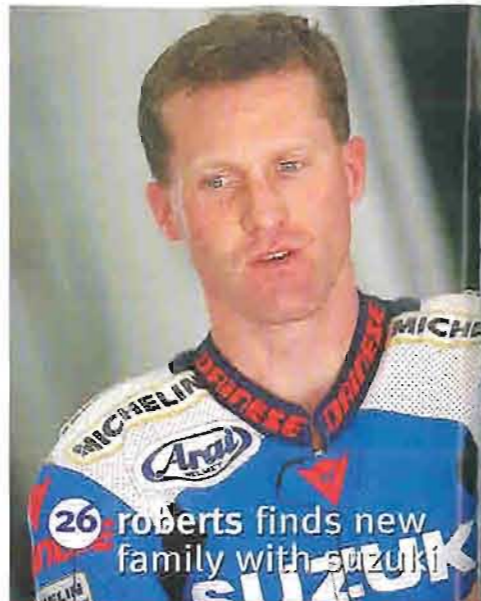
What a start

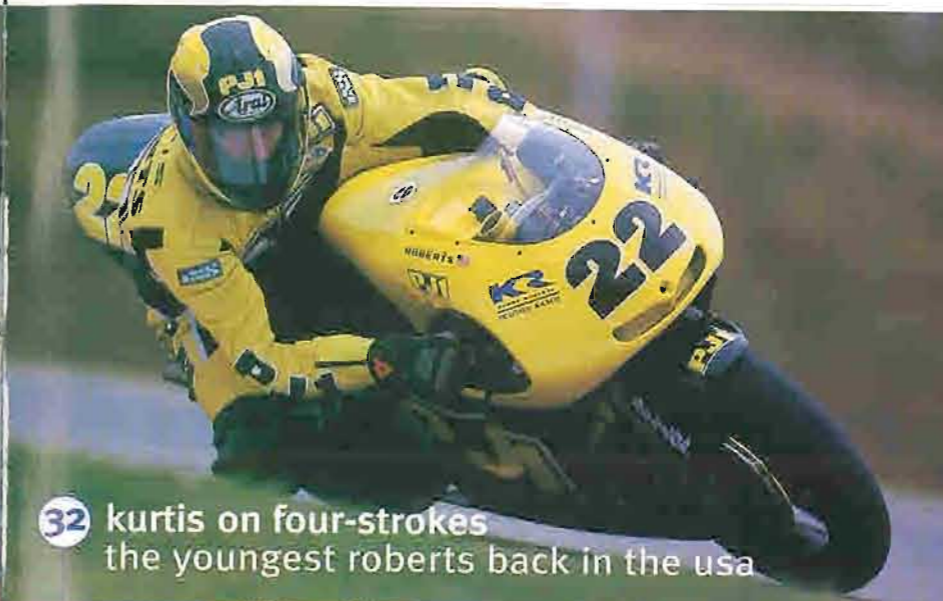

 See you there to find out the answers to both questions - and many more, no doubt....

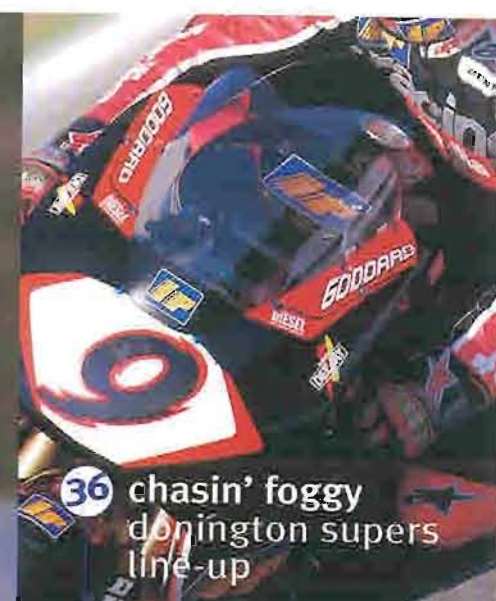
